Meal Plan Choice (only Kent, Stuart, and SSV Apartment residents are exempt from a meal plan)

Meal: "Meal" is the unit of tender a student uses to eat at the Resident Dining Cafeteria during mealtimes. A student, unless signed up for the Unlimited Plan, may use a meal only once per meal period (breakfast, lunch, and dinner are meal periods).
Bonus Points: Bonus points allow students to purchase meals or snacks at any Sodexho outlet or Global Grounds. They are included with resident meal plans as indicated below.
Hawk Points: Hawk points allow students to purchase meals or snacks at any Sodexho outlet or Global Grounds. They may be purchased to supplement bonus points.

Resident Meal Plans

Unlimited Plan	[\$4,020]	Enter and eat at the Resident Dining Cafeteria as often as you like 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. includes \$25 in bonus points each semester.
Block Plan	[\$3,620]	Access to 150 meals for the semester includes \$100 in bonus points each semester.
14 Plan	[\$3,620]	14 meals in a 7 day period includes \$125 in bonus points each semester.
19 Plan	[\$3,620]	19 meals in a 7 day period includes \$25 in bonus points each semester.
5 Plan	[\$1,210]	5 meals in a 7 day period. Available only to Graduate students who are assigned to Graduate Hall, Kent, Stuart, SSV Apartment residents and commuters.

Commuter Meal Options

Any of the Resident Meal Plans noted above. Charges for meal plans may be applied to student account.

UCuisine Card [\$25 initial purchase] UCuisine cards are prepaid, declining balance, debit cards where value may be added in any amount after the initial purchase. UCuisine cards may be purchased from and used only at Sodexho outlets. UCuisine cards may not be used at Global Grounds.

Points and bonus points offered with meal plans roll over from Fall to Spring semester.
Meal plan changes are allowed with prior approval during the first and second weeks of classes each semester.
Winter break housing does not include meal privileges but bonus points may be used.
No breakfast will be served during Fall and Spring break periods and the Thanksgiving Holiday.
Meal service for the Fall semester is provided between brunch on Aug. 21, 2005 and dinner on Dec. 17, 2005.
Meal service for the Spring semester is provided between brunch on Jan. 14, 2006 and dinner on May 13, 2006.

Important dates to remember

[August 21, 2005]	Residence Halls open Meal Plans begins today.
[September 9, 2005]	DEADLINE to request a meal plan change for the fall semester.
[December 17, 2005]	Full meal service for the Fall Semester ends with dinner.
[January 14, 2006]	Full meal service for the Spring Semester begins with brunch.
[January 27, 2006]	DEADLINE to request a meal plan change for the spring semester.
[May 13, 2006]	Meal plan contracts end with dinner.

Board Cancellation Policy

This agreement is for the entire academic year, or remaining balance thereof at the time of meal plan activation. Students who cancel their board contract for any reason will be assessed cancellation penalty charges as follows:

<u>Time of cancellation (Fall or Spring semester)</u>	<u>Board Penalty</u>
From Residence Hall Opening until First Day of Classes	10%
During First Week of Classes	20%
During Second Week of Classes	40%
During Third Week of Classes	60%
During Fourth Week of Classes	80%
After Fourth Week of Classes	100%
